- 4. Applicants must include two current letters of recommendation. One must be from a church leader: i.e. Elder, Deacons, youth leader, pastor, etc. The other can be from a person of the applicant's choosing.
- 5. Applicants must submit a copy of a high school or college transcript with the application. Note: If you are applying for the FPC church scholarship and the Leslie Paulson Scholarship, one copy of the transcript will be used for both applications.
