## Scholarship Criteria:

- 1. Applicant must be an active participant in a Christian church within the local area and must have achieved a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher in the high school or college most recently attended. Volunteer involvement in church, school, or community will enhance the application.
- 2. Students of all ages who are attending or committed to attending a 4-year college or university, community college, or accredited Vocational/technical School in either an undergraduate or graduate program may apply.
- 3. In selecting the recipients, merit and financial need will be equally considered.
- 4. Preference will be given to students majoring in education with a desire to teach.
- 5. Applicants must submit a copy of a high school or college transcript with the application. Note: If you are applying for the FPC church scholarship and the Leslie Paulson Scholarship, one copy of the transcript will be used for both applications.
- 6. Two letters of recommendation are required ~ <u>One must be from the pastor of the applicant's church</u> and the other is of the applicant's choice.
- Scholarship applicants must be submitted to First Presbyterian Church of Puyallup By Wednesday May 14<sup>th</sup> 2025.

## Selection of Scholarship Recipients:

- 1. The Scholarship Committee of the First Presbyterian Church of Puyallup makes selection of recipients. Scholarships are announced on Graduate Recognition Sunday. Recipients are requested to attend this worship service if possible.
- 2. A degree of preference will be given to applicants active in the First Presbyterian Church of Puyallup.
- 3. The Scholarship Committee will determine the number and amounts of scholarships offered each year. The minimum amount of scholarships will be \$2,000.
- 4. The Scholarship Committee is not required to disburse any or all the scholarship funds each year. The quantity and the quality of the applicants on a year-to-year basis will determine this.
